Horseback Riding Enjoy an authentic trail ride on one of our famous palomino horses. All riders will wear provided helmets. Children seven and under will be given corral rides. *Please bring appropriate riding attire and closed toed shoes. *No slip-ons or crocs are allowed.*

Night Hike What goes bump in the night? Our staff may lead your family on a night hike to enjoy the sites and sounds of Rock Springs in the dark.

Activity Costs Rifle shooting is 50¢ for 5 shots, trap is 50¢ per shot, and crafts = the cost of each item created.

Fun Facts about Rock Springs:

- A natural spring supplies all of Rock Springs 4-H Center's water resources and has never been known to fail!
- The Spring supplies 1,000 gallons of water per minute and the average temperature is 54° Fahrenheit.
- Rock Springs is a year-round facility that hosts over 20,000 visitors annually for camps, retreats, conferences and family reunions.
- Rock Springs & Camp WaShunGa can house nearly 900 people at full capacity.
- The oldest part of the ranch house was built in 1883 and still stands today.
- The water wheel that pumps the Spring is rare for Kansas and is made from an old tractor hub.
- One stone wall from an original cabin built in 1857 still stands by the craft center.
- A country church built in 1885 and a one room school house from 1887 can be explored on the grounds.
